A. Objective

The purpose of this event is to enable students to address real-life problems through technology, helping them think about their roles and responsibilities in the world and become responsible global citizens. This event aims to connect national high school students with international social issues and achieve the following educational goals through problem-solving practices:

- 1. Encourage high school students nationwide to apply their knowledge and demonstrate their design thinking and problem-solving skills.
- 2. Guide high school students to brainstorm innovative ideas through interdisciplinary collaboration in the competition.
- 3. Provide students with opportunities for interdisciplinary exchange under the theme "Using Large Language Models to Solve SDG Issues" to inspire creativity and solve real-life problems.

B. Participants

High school students (Form 4 to Form 6) from the Kuala Lumpur and Selangor region.

C. Event Duration

From now until December 31, 2024.


E. Registration

G. Competition Language

Workshops will be conducted in both Chinese and English. The final submission of the report must be presented in English. During the presentation, it can be delivered in either Chinese or English.

H. Competition Rules

1. Participants must ensure that the images, videos, design elements, etc., they use do not infringe on any copyrights, trademarks, or other proprietary rights of any person or entity. In case of infringement, the organizer reserves the right to disqualify the participant.

I. Prizes

First Prize (Gold Medal): Cash RM 1,500 and a certificate for each team member.

Second Prize (Silver Medal): Cash RM 1,200 and a certificate for each team member.


Third Prize (Bronze Medal): Cash RM 900 and a certificate for each team member.

Excellence Award (2 awards): Cash RM 600 and a certificate for each team member.

J. Notes

- Participating teams must complete the check-in by 9:00 AM on August 4, 2024 (Saturday). Failure to check in will be considered as forfeiting the competition.
- 2. The competition venue will provide wireless internet, power, and refreshments. Participants should bring their own laptops, smartphones, and other materials or equipment needed to complete their work, ensuring they do not disrupt others.
- 3. After registration is confirmed, team members cannot be changed. Each team must appoint a leader responsible for competition contact and related matters. Teams must allocate the responsibilities and roles of team members internally; the organizer will not intervene.
- 4. Participants cannot register with multiple teams or submit multiple registrations.

- 5. The organizer does not provide computers or adapters; participants must bring their own. Due to on-site power safety considerations, participants are not allowed to use extension cords at the final venue.
- 6. The event will last one day, with the organizer providing morning tea, lunch, and afternoon tea.
- 7. Participants must comply with the regulations in Attachment 1; otherwise, the organizer reserves the right to disqualify them and revoke their awards.
- 8. Participants agree to allow the organizer to use their photos and works taken during the competition for competition publicity, reports, event websites, and exhibitions.
- 9. Winning teams should cooperate in attending the results exhibition and related promotions.
- 10. If the event cannot be held due to force majeure, the organizer has the right to cancel, terminate, modify, or suspend the event.
- 11. Participants diagnosed with a contagious disease by a doctor (with medical proof) must comply with epidemic prevention regulations and inform the organizer. They will not be allowed to participate, but other team members can continue to compete.
